BID AUGUST HIGHLIGHTS

Angels Walk Stanchions



The 16-piece, 7-foot-high, 2-foot-wide historic marker or stanchion developed by Angels Walk L.A. was installed in early August. Stanchions can be viewed at their designated locations in accordance with the Angels Walk guide book through out Chinatown. These

stanchions provide a self-guided walking trail through the heart of Los Angeles commemorating the history, architecture and cultural aspects of Chinatown in both English and Chinese. Locations to view the stanchions can be found in front of Central Plaza, PAMC, Phoenix Bakery, and Little Joe's, to name a few. For a full listing, contact the BID office for a copy of the Angels Walk guide book. "We can be very proud of this project and our insistence on the Chinese translation for the stanchion. We hope members of the community can also come to appreciate their significance" said BID Executive Director George Yu. A reception will be coordinated to formally thank all those involved with this project.

Central Plaza Street Paving

The streets of Central Plaza have been freshly asphalted as of the end of June. The project entailed covering up all the cracks and raising the level of the streets to meet the curbs, thus greatly reducing the potential for pedestrian tripping. Funding for the project was provided by the BID.

Central Plaza Wishing Well

The BID is working closely with the L.A. Chinatown Corporation to review proposals to restore the wishing well located on Gin Ling Way in Central Plaza. The City of L.A.'s Department of Public Works has contributed funds through its "Neighborhood Matching Fund Program" toward this project.

Dodger Shuttle

With its brightly "wrapped" exterior, the Chinatown Dodger Shuttle catches a lot of looks these days. Thanks to the help of several local sponsors, the shuttle bus now has eye-catching

graphics. Chinatown Business Improvement District, Bond Company, Laeroc Partners, and Planning Company Associates have all



put their logos on the bus and have contributed funds to enable Chinatown to make a bold statement. The Dodger Shuttle will run every Friday night of a Dodgers home game from the Gold Line Station to Dodger Stadium. Next shuttle date is Friday, August 20th Dodgers vs. Atlanta.

Historic Plaque Program

Historic buildings and monuments within Chinatown will soon harbor plaques designating their significance and detailing a bit of history about the area. The first set of plaques to be installed will be in the streets of Central Plaza explaining how roads and such byways came to be so named. The Historic Plaque Program will compliment and enhance the Angels Walk stanchions and the Angels Walk self-guided historic walking tour of Chinatown.

Moon Festival

Save the date: September 25th. The BID & the Chinese Chamber of Commerce continues to plan for the annual Autumn Moon Festival taking place on September 25th in Central Plaza. More information will be forthcoming.

Night Market

Due to the popular reception of the trial Night Market during April, the BID will work to resume the Night Market & weekend entertainment series on a regular basis at Central Plaza from 4pm-8pm. They will feature merchandise, arts and crafts with magic shows and cultural entertainment. Upcoming dates: 8/14, 8/28, 9/11, 9/25.

Public Art Project

The BID is working with "LA Commons" to bring art designed by local artists to the public with funding from UCLA in LA. Pending approval, three Chinatown venues will play host to a photographic display by Shan Chao (at the Chinatown Library), a lantern project by Cindy Suriyani (at Central Plaza) and a souvenir shop road trip by Annie Shaw (at the Chinatown Gold Line Station). The art is slated to debut with fanfare around the Chinatown Moon Festival (September 25).

天使行柱標

道奇往返巴士
