



## Chinese Food Festival Approaches

Planning for the BID's biggest yearly event, the Chinese Food Festival, continues at full throttle.

Over 25 restaurants are expected to participate, all of which feature Chinese or Chinese-influenced cuisine. Cooking demonstrations are also on the menu and the list of participating chefs is growing.



Entertainment headliners include the Hsiao Hsi Yuan Puppet Theater, which is traveling here from Taiwan and will do three special festival performances.

The 2005 Chinese Food Festival will take place in the heart of Chinatown in Central Plaza, an easy stroll from Chinatown's Metro Gold Line Station. Festival hours are Saturday from 10am – 8pm and Sunday from 11am – 6pm.

The festival promises to be one of the best bargains in town! General admission is \$10; seniors (60+) pay \$8; youths (5-12) pay \$6, and children under 5 are free. (Includes 2 food tastings except for kids under 5.) A \$2 discount is offered off of the general admission price only with proof of riding public transportation to the festival. (Discount does not apply to Senior or Youth admission.)

Ocean Seafood, Hop Woo, and Hop Li were the featured restaurants at our July 15 progressive dinner, and Chow Fun, Asian Noodles and CBS Seafood will be featured on August 17.

Each evening's prix-fixe menu will feature dishes specially selected by the



three chefs and will be paired with wine selected by Du Vin.

The project temporarily transforms a 32-acre brownfield on the edge of Chinatown into an agricultural and

community-programming site, under the artistic direction of Lauren Bon with funds from the Annenberg Foundation. In addition to the germination of corn over an 11 acre-area, a number of events including a drum circle, film screenings, and lectures will be presented on the site over the coming months.
