First Annual Christmas Tree Lighting in Chinatown

The holidays are a magical time of year, and what better way to experience holiday magic than in Los Angeles' most unique neighborhood. Chinatown is hosting its first ever Christmas tree lighting on Thursday, Dec. 2, 2010 beginning at 6 p.m. with live music, special performances and spectacular tree lighting at dusk to celebrate the splendor of the season.

The Noble Fir is decorated by renowned Floral and Holiday Designer Brad Schmidt in a uniquely Chinatown theme. The celebration will begin with youth performers from Pasadena Music Center and Conservatory singing classic

and modern Christmas carols. In addition to the tree lighting, Chinatown BID will be hosting a toy drive for families in need this holiday season. A toy collection repository will be placed in the center of Central Plaza during the tree lighting event and the toy collection will continue through Dec. 19th. Please bring unwrapped children's gifts appropriate for children ages 1 - 17 years old.

This event is free and open to all ages—bring the entire family to Chinatown for what promises to be a truly unforgettable day and night. After the event, enjoy post-festivity dinners at one of many Chinatown restaurant and eateries.

BID SUCCESSFULLY RENEWED FOR ANOTHER 10 YEARS!

The BID, established in 2000, has been focused on facilitating the revitalization of historic Chinatown. The initial term and agreement between the City of Los Angeles and the BID will be completed by December 31, 2010. Notices were sent and ballots were cast prior to the September City Council Public Hearing. The City Clerk's office tabulated the results and announced that the Chinatown BID was renewed by an overwhelming majority. The renewal of the Greater Chinatown Business Improvement District is approved for another 10 years beginning January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2020. The BID will be electing new board members to serve 1- and 2-year terms in November. Nomination letters has been sent out in October to all property owners. Results will be forthcoming following the November Board Meeting.

This year's BID Annual Town Hall forum will take place on Thursday, December 2nd. During this time, we also want to express our appreciation to all the BID supporters for the BID to be renewed for another 10 years. Thanksgiving Chinatown Style!

Chinatown Los Angeles restaurants and merchants are offering a unique approach to the traditional Thanksgiving fowl by offering BBQ-roasted turkeys for November; a few are offering through the end of the year. A holiday favorite for Angelenos, many have driven from miles outside the city into Chinatown to grab these flavorful birds for their holiday meals.

Prepared similarly to traditional Chinese roasted duck, the turkeys have a crispy, seared skin and better-preserved juices than oven-roasted turkeys. Stuffing is also done Chinese style—instead of bread stuffing many Chinatown merchants offer sticky rice stuffing with sausage, mushrooms and other variations of ingredients.

Since these turkeys are very popular around this time of year, Chinatown merchants suggest placing turkey orders at least one week ahead of time. For more information, visit www.ChinatownLA.com.
